ELECTRIC SUMMER ACCESS GUIDE

SITE DESCRIPTION

UK weather can be changeable - rain, warm temperatures and strong winds can make the surface of the event wet. Please check for any weather warnings on the day of your booking and, if in doubt, bring waterproof clothing.

LIGHTING

Whilst there is no strobe lighting, some of the festive lights may include pulsating or flashing.

ESSENTIAL COMPANION TICKETS

As Electric summer is a free to enter event, no entry ticket is required. Tickets will be provided for Companions or Personal Assistants for standard adult ticket holders who require additional assistance, at no additional cost for the rides. For those with Child and Teen tickets, Personal Assistant ticket shall also be provided if required, at no additional cost, but the child or teen must be accompanied by a paying adult ticket holder (such adult ticket holder may be the Companion or Personal Assistant).

To help us provide the best possible service, our ticketing partner TodayTix has collaborated with Nimbus Disability to use the Access Card Scheme, making ticket booking and access simpler for customers with accessibility requirements.

At Electric Summer, we're proud to support the Access Card Scheme, a nationally recognised system that helps make events more accessible and inclusive.

Guests who require assistance to attend our event, can book a free Essential Companion ticket online if they hold an Access Card with a +1 or +2 symbol.

If you don't have an Access Card, our partners at Nimbus offer a **free** application for a **TodayTix Digital Access Pass** for Electric Summer. Once approved, you'll be able to book an Essential Companion ticket online.

The above scheme and facilities are for customers with permanent/ long term access requirements and are not for people with temporary impairments such as broken bones, healing wounds or people who are pregnant. PA's attending through this scheme must be 18 years old by the start of the event.

BOOKING TICKETS

Please select the date and time you would like to book our rides from the availability on our booking page.

Select the required type and number of entry tickets. Please ensure to add your free of charge Essential Companion/ Personal Assistant ticket to your booking. The Essential Companion Ticket must be added alongside a paid adult entry ticket. You will need to present the relevant documentation at our Box Office, to pick up your Essential Companion ticket(s). This will be assessed on a case-by-case basis. Tickets will be cancelled if proof is not provided on the day.

RELEVANT DOCUMENTS

Examples of relevant documentation are as follows:

- DLA (Disability Living Allowance)
- PIP (Personal Independence Payment)
- Evidence of registered severely sight impaired (blind)
- CredAbility Access Card (with +1 icon)
- Copy of Attendance Allowance letter
- Recognised Assistance Dog ID card
- Any other relevant documentation

WHEELCHAIR ACCESS

Wave Swinger has stairs to enter, so not accessible to all

Dodgems there are four steps to access the ride

The Big Wheel 1 x Wheelchair gondola with ramp available (Capacity of 1 x wheelchair user + 1 other)

Roller Rink Yes, and we have an accessible and low-sensory session available.

The bar rooftop would not be wheelchair accessible

ACCESSIBLE SESSIONS

Our accessible skate sessions have a lower capacity of guests, have reduced levels of music/sound as well as lighting.

MEDICAL FACILITIES

We have first aid medical facilities on site.

ASSISTANCE DOGS

Glide at Battersea Power Station is committed to making sure the event is inclusive and accessible to all, and we understand that some customers will rely on an assistance dog to attend our events.

Glide at Battersea Power Station reserves the right to turn away dogs who do not comply with Assistance Dogs UK guidelines surrounding assistance dogs.

In order to ensure the smoothest entry possible, we would advise contacting our customer service team so that they can help facilitate your entry at the event and provide necessary information regarding the venue.

Please note that dogs are not permitted on the rides.

PARKING

Parking is available on Electric Boulevard (SW11 8BH) 24 hours a day. To access the Electric Boulevard car park, enter from Battersea Park Road and drive along Pump House Lane and go down the car park ramp on the left-hand side, labelled 'Public Car Park'. At the

bottom of the ramp, keep following the signs to the Public Car Park. Please note, there are a limited number of spaces available and different tariffs apply

BATTERSEA POWER STATION ALSO PROVIDE ACCESSIBILITY SERVICES

You can view them directly [here](#) on their website. The Guest Services desks are located just inside the North Entrance (Upper Ground Floor) and South Entrance (Ground Floor) of the Power Station. We have outlined the key points below:

- Accessible Toilets

Accessible toilets are located throughout the Power Station and require a RADAR key for entry. For guests who do not have their own RADAR key, please contact the staff at the Guest Services desk or call 020 8176 6500 and a team member will come and unlock the stall for you.

Battersea Power Station also has an accessible toilet, ensuring accessible facilities for all passengers and making travel easier for those with mobility needs.

- Blue Badge Parking

There is a total of 45 Disabled parking spaces available in the Circus West Village and the Electric Boulevard car parks – these spaces are available specifically for use by Blue Badge holders. These spaces are not bookable in advance and are charged at standard rates.

- British Sign Language (BSL) Interpreting

The Guest Services team at Battersea Power station offers instant access to live BSL interpreting through CONVO. This service enables seamless, real-time communication between the staff and Deaf or hard-of-hearing guests, making it easier to ask questions, get assistance, and enjoy a fully inclusive experience.

- Changing Places

The Changing Places facility is located on the ground floor, north side next to a shop called Swatch and is accessible using a RADAR key. If you do not have your own RADAR key, please ask a member of the staff at the Guest Services desk or call 020 8176 6500 and a team member will come and unlock the stall for you.

- Electric Scooters & Wheelchair Hire

Mobility scooters and manual wheelchairs are available for hire. Please click [here](#) for the booking process and please click [here](#) for their standard terms and conditions. Mobility equipment is available during operational hours only.

- Elevators

The Power Station includes multiple accessibility-focused elevators with internal dimensions of 250cm depth by 150cm width and a clear door opening of 110cm. The lift provides adequate turning space to support wheelchair users and individuals using mobility aids, ensuring safe and inclusive vertical access throughout the building.

- Hearing loops

The Guest Services desk is equipped with hearing loops to ensure clear communication for visitors with hearing aids or cochlear implants. These systems provide enhanced audio clarity by transmitting sound directly to compatible devices, making it easier for guests to engage with staff and access important information.

- Hidden Disabilities Sunflower Scheme

We recognise the hidden disabilities sunflower as a way of you voluntarily sharing that you may need a helping hand, understanding, or more time. Sunflower lanyards are available from the Guest Services team,

- Recite me

We now provide an inclusive online experience to enable website visitors to access online content and services barrier-free. The Recite Me assistive toolbar on this website includes screen reading functionality, multiple reading aids, customisable styling options, and an on-demand live translation feature that boots over 100 languages including 65 text-to-speech and styling options.

- Sensory Back Packs

Sensory Backpacks are available to hire for free from the Guest Services Desks; these backpacks contain over-ear headphones, sunglasses, fidget toys and communication cards.

- Visually Impaired Assistance

As part of the access services provided by the Guest Services Team at Battersea Power Station Companion Canes are available ahead of your visit

- WelcoMe

The WelcoMe app enables you to notify us of your visit and of any additional support you may need, helping to make your visit more predictable. WelcoMe is free to use and is available for download from your app store.

ADDITIONAL SERVICES PROVIDED BY BATTERSEA POWER STATION.

- Prayer Room

The prayer room is located on the ground floor, north side through the corridor adjacent to the Waterstones in Turbine Hall B.

- Baby Changing and Family Room

Baby changing areas are conveniently located throughout the Power Station for your ease and comfort. Their dedicated Family Rooms are situated on Level 1 of Turbine Hall B (North Side)

Baby changing facilities are also available within both male and female toilet blocks. If you need assistance finding the nearest facility, please don't hesitate to approach a member of the Guest Services team.
